ALL FIELD USAGE RENTAL PROCEDURES AND FEE SCHEDULE

Field conditions, maintenance schedules and the number of hours of available usage on a particular field will determine field availability.

The Town of Stonington reserves the right to restrict, refuse, or cancel the use of any field for the following reasons:

1. The field is either closed for:
 - maintenance and repairs
 - overuse
 - limited town resources
2. Requested use is inappropriate and/or may damage the field due to opposing wear patterns that may result in unsafe playing conditions; therefore, the playing of two sports in the same season on the same field may not be permitted.
3. Other instances as deemed necessary:
 - Those who have secured fields are:
 - An invoice will be processed indicating a due date for the rental fee.
 - Required to inform Stonington Recreation if they are not using the dates/times that have been reserved.
 - Responsible for following the Town of Stonington policies/ordinances.
 - Required to submit a Certificate of Insurance or must sign a Liability and Indemnification Agreement/Release of Liability, which is found on the Field Request Form.
 - Stonington Public School activities have priority on town/school fields.
 - Stonington Recreation sponsored programs have priority on town/school fields when Stonington Public School activities are not scheduled.
 - Stonington Recreation is responsible for assigning recognized community youth athletic organizations to designated sport-specific fields. The amount of field use time allocated to each community youth athletic organization is at the discretion of Stonington Recreation and is determined by the availability of space to provide the specified activity.

2. Non-profit groups whose membership is comprised of a majority of Stonington residents.

NON-PROFIT OUT OF TOWN

1. Non-profit, youth and adult athletic organizations whose membership is not comprised of a majority of Stonington residents and/or are full time employees of a business located in Stonington.
2. Non-profit groups whose membership is not comprised of a majority of Stonington residents.

FOR PROFIT GROUP

1. For-profit groups, businesses, camps, etc.

Class A Grass Field

Ideal use for competition due to meeting standard regulations for all youth, high school and adult sports.

Class B Grass Field

Ideal use for practice and limited youth recreational competition. All fields do not meet the standard regulations for most youth, high school and adult sports.
