EXECUTIVE ORDER #006

WHEREAS, the City of New London desires to strengthen and improve its short term and long term fiscal condition, and,

WHEREAS, the FY 2012-2013 budget adopted by the City Council requires the City to impose new fiscal constraints on services and staffing levels, and,

WHEREAS, the administration seeks to identify and rectify any line item expenditures in the 2012-2013 fiscal year that may cause a line item deficit, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 39 (b) of the Charter of the City of New London, the Mayor shall direct and control all City Departments, and,

WHEREAS, no permit for any special event, parade, or street closure may issue without the approval of the Mayor, and,

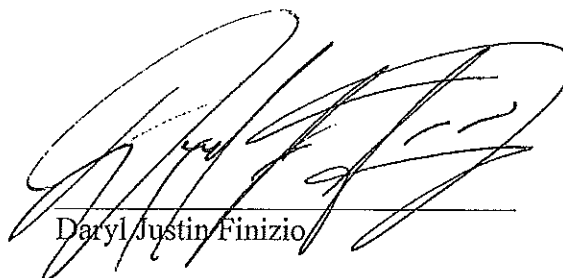
WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 40 of the Charter of the City of New London, the Mayor shall control the administrative service of the City,

Now, Therefore, pursuant to my authority as Chief Executive Officer of the City of New London, I hereby order and direct as follows:

1. Each Department Director shall report to the Mayor, in writing, if, at any time during FY 2012-2013, any line item in their department's budget is projected to incur a deficit for the year. The Mayor's office will also immediately forward any such report to the City Council.
2. Should any staff position become vacant in FY 2012-2013 in any department, and the department director determines that departmental functions can continue to the end of the fiscal year without filling the vacant post; the position shall remain vacant until the end of the fiscal year.
3. No permit for any special event, parade, or any other activity shall issue without a full cost accounting of the event's fiscal impact on City services. No permit for any event shall issue unless the full cost estimated for the event is paid, in advance, to the City by the event coordinators; unless the event, and its costs, are specifically authorized by a resolution of the City Council.

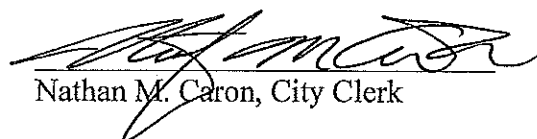
4. The administration will prepare and release, no later than 12/31/2012, a 10 year projected fiscal and capital plan for the City of New London. The administration will work closely with the City Council and Board of Education in the preparation of this plan, which shall include long term revenue and tax assessment projections, long term City projected fiscal needs, and long term projected necessary capital projects.
