
On October 10, 2013, you were served by Captain Todd Bergeson with Supervisor's Complaint 2013-32 for violation of New London Police Department General Order 8.6.11(f) release of information to the media, General Order 10.6a(3) Department use and security, General Order 10.7(1), (8) Electronic Messaging and General Order 12.0 (11) Truthfulness (2 counts).

According to the incident details, between July 20, 2013 and July 30, 2013 an internal police document was released to the new media. This document was found to have been released by you. A forensic document examiner was retained by the City and compared the document to your handwriting samples and opined that your handwriting was on the released document. On August 28, 2013, you were untruthful in a memorandum submitted to the department regarding this released document. Furthermore, on October 10, 2013, you were questioned with your union present and with legal counsel about the released document and you were untruthful in your responses.

You were directed to appear at a pre-disciplinary hearing on November 25, 2013. Present at the hearing was Police Chief Margaret Ackley, Deputy Police Chief Peter Reichard, Captain Todd Bergeson and Attorney Brian Estep of the Law Director's office. You appeared with Attorney Eric Brown, Officer Todd Lynch and Officer Darrin O'Mara. At the hearing you were provided the opportunity to give a statement or present evidence. You stated that you stood by your previous statements regarding the released document.

After a careful review of the investigation and the Chief's recommendation, you are hereby terminated from your employment with the City of New London, effective immediately.
