Dear Governor Malloy,

I want to thank you for taking the time to meet with me to discuss future development in and around the Fort Trumbull peninsula in the City of New London.

For the reasons that I have discussed with you, I believe the time has come to reform the development relationship that exists between the State, the City of New London, and the Renaissance City Development Association.

To move forward within the parameters we discussed, I would require a letter from you to myself clarifying the State's position relative to the following three points:

1. The State will not object to RCDA transferring the deeds to land which may be transferable to the City of New London.
2. The State will not object to any reasonable requests from the City and RCDA for modifications to the MDP.
3. The State will not object to RCDA being funded by the City of New London instead of State DECD.


I firmly believe that your acceptance of this proposal would be a game-changing decision that would finally spur meaningful economic development in and around the Fort Trumbull peninsula.
